## **3 Baseload units remain offline, load-shedding schedule issued** *GPA continue working on repairs to stabilize power system*

(Fadian, Mangilao) – Today, 3 baseload units remain offline. Consequently, GPA will begin rotating outages lasting up to one hour starting later this evening. GPA is making every effort to provide sufficient power supply to meet the island's demand. However current conditions could continue thru this Wednesday.

Piti 8 is now anticipated to return to service on Tuesday, August 16, and Cabras 2 by Wednesday, August 17. Once these units are operational, power interruptions should cease as supply will meet demand.

The load shedding schedule is posted on GPA's website and social media pages including Instagram and Facebook. A load shedding schedule is provided to assist customers in planning in case an outage may occur but does not mean a power interruption is imminent. Although GPA has been issuing this schedule for the past few days, most outages were avoided. However, they are provided so customers could plan in the event it is necessary.

GPA continues to use its GWA asset generators and Interruptible Load customers GIAA, PAG and GRMC to minimize shortages.

We ask everyone to please conserve energy most especially between the hours of 6pm to 9pm which is when power demand is highest and the time period load shedding is most likely to occur.
