GUAM SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY TO REMAIN OPEN ON MONDAY, 10/9/23, AHEAD OF TROPICAL STORM BOLAVEN; OPERATIONAL CHANGES EFFECTIVE 10/10/23

(Guam, October 9, 2023) – The Guam Solid Waste Authority (GSWA) today announced operational changes due to the approaching Tropical Storm Bolaven.

In response to the approaching Tropical Storm Bolaven and in accordance with Governor Lou Leon Guerrero's declaration of Condition of Readiness (COR) 2 at 8 p.m. on October 8, 2023, GSWA has temporarily adjusted its operations as follows:

- GSWA Administrative and Customer Service offices, Residential Transfer Stations, Layon Landfill, and the Hauler Only Transfer Station will be open for normal business hours today, Monday, October 9, 2023 and trash collection services will continue as scheduled for Monday customers, ensuring minimal disruptions to our services.
- GSWA facilities will be closed and trash collection services will be temporarily suspended effective Tuesday, October 10, 2023 until the Governor declares COR 4 or unless otherwise announced by GSWA.

Customers are strongly advised to securely store their trash and recycle bins. This precaution will help prevent the loss or scattering of waste and recyclables during adverse weather conditions and prevent potential hazards.
