AREA: Customers affected are along a portion of Maria Candelaria Road, Hegai Street, Uma Street, Biradan Gotee Street, Tuba Street, Biradan Bukayo, Pinga Street, Hatsa Street, Uke Street, Chanka Road, Un Road A, S-1, S-3, and S-4 Road, and surrounding areas.

Other customers affected include GWA booster pump.

***SCOPE OF WORK:** GPA Line crew will be replacing wooden poles with concrete poles and change out of cross arms.

WHY WILL MY POWER BE OFF?

GPA makes system improvements and conducts preventative maintenance to avoid future power outages. In most cases, the job can be done with no impact to customers; however, sometimes the power needs to be shut off in order for the crews to work safely. Isolating power lines are necessary for safety precaution. We understand that this can be inconvenient and uncomfortable. We are committed to keeping our customers and employees safe and we will turn the power back on as soon as we can.

WHAT CAN I DO?

- If you have a generator, make sure your main breaker is in the open position for the safety of our line crew.
- Have a plan for alternate power source for electrical medical equipment.
- Charge all cell phones.
- Minimize opening refrigerator and freezer doors during the outage.
