

PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE OUTAGE

VILLAGE: Tamuning

AREA: Customers affected are along E.T. Calvo Memorial Parkway, L&C Matias Street (Tun Leonardo Matias Street), Tun Jose Salas Street, Guerrero Drive, Tun Joaquin Guerrero Street (aka Pick-A-Nail Street), and surrounding areas.

Other customers affected include a portion of Atkins Kroll Guam, Camacho Landmark Center Buildings 1, 2 & 3 (to include all vendors/tenants), Hafa Adai Exchange, FHP/Take Care Insurance, ITC Building, Tamuning Post Office, Personal Finance Center, Bank of Hawaii, Pacific Tyre, Shell Gas Station, ESC Pacific, GPIS Guam, Auto Worx Air Conditioning, Phoenix Pacific, Carpet Masters/The Shutter Factory, The King Imports, Express Signs and Graphics, Isla Coatings and Roofing Supply, Brownstone Construction, Dickerson & Quinn, Dial Rent to Own Office, CTSI Logistics Guam, and surrounding customers. **Please note that Guam Memorial Hospital and Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center will not be affected by these outages.**

***SCOPE OF WORK:** GPA Line crew will be re-configuring and removing power lines.

In addition, two (2) traffic lights along Chalan San Antonio will be affected during this outage.

- 1) Traffic light at the intersection of Chalan San Antonio and Marine Drive (ITC Intersection).
- 2) Traffic light at the intersection by Guam Premier Outlets.

Please use caution when driving in this area. Motorists should expect traffic delays.

WHY WILL MY POWER BE OFF?

GPA makes system improvements and conducts preventative maintenance to avoid future power outages. In most cases, the job can be done with no impact to customers; however, sometimes the power needs to be shut off in order for the crews to work safely. Isolating power lines are necessary for safety precaution. We understand that this can be inconvenient and uncomfortable. We are committed to keeping our customers and employees safe and we will turn the power back on as soon as we can.

WHAT CAN I DO?

- **If you have a generator, make sure your main breaker is in the open position for the safety of our line crew.**
- Have a plan for alternate power source for electrical medical equipment.
- Charge all cell phones.
- Minimize opening refrigerator and freezer doors during the outage.
