

PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE OUTAGE



DATE: Friday, October 31, 2025
TIME: First at 12:00 a.m. to 12:30 a.m. (30 minutes)
Then again at 5:30 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. (30 minutes)
FEEDER: P-203
VILLAGE: Tamuning
AREA: Customers affected are along Chalan San Antonio northbound (from Route 1/Chalan San Antonio intersection to the Hornet Building), Farenholt Avenue westbound, to include a portion of Governor Carlos Camacho Road, Jonestown, and surrounding areas.

***SCOPE OF WORK:** GPA Line crew will be re-configuring and removing power lines.

In addition, the following traffic light will be affected during the two (2) 30-minute outages:

1) Traffic light at the intersection of Chalan San Antonio and Fahrenholt Avenue by PeMar Place (former Sagua Mañagu).

Please use caution when driving in this area. Motorists should expect traffic delays.

WHY WILL MY POWER BE OFF?

GPA makes system improvements and conducts preventative maintenance to avoid future power outages. In most cases, the job can be done with no impact to customers; however, sometimes the power needs to be shut off in order for the crews to work safely. Isolating power lines are necessary for safety precaution. We understand that this can be inconvenient and uncomfortable. We are committed to keeping our customers and employees safe and we will turn the power back on as soon as we can.

WHAT CAN I DO?

- **If you have a generator, make sure your main breaker is in the open position for the safety of our line crew.**
- Have a plan for alternate power source for electrical medical equipment.
- Charge all cell phones.
- Minimize opening refrigerator and freezer doors during the outage.
