

PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE OUTAGE

VILLAGE: Dededo (Macheche Area)

AREA: Customers affected are along Ahau Lane, East Corenoso Street, West Corenoso Street, a portion of East Suni Drive, Ayuyu Street, a portion of Macheche Avenue, and surrounding areas.

Other customers also affected include Macheche Community Center (to include Macheche Adult Care Center) and surrounding businesses.

***SCOPE OF WORK:** GPA Line crew will be installing one concrete pole and upgrading power lines.

WHY WILL MY POWER BE OFF?

GPA makes system improvements and conducts preventative maintenance to avoid future power outages. In most cases, the job can be done with no impact to customers; however, sometimes the power needs to be shut off in order for the crews to work safely. Isolating power lines are necessary for safety precaution. We understand that this can be inconvenient and uncomfortable. We are committed to keeping our customers and employees safe and we will turn the power back on as soon as we can.

WHAT CAN I DO?

- If you have a generator, make sure your main breaker is in the open position for the safety of our line crew.
- Have a plan for alternate power source for electrical medical equipment.
- Charge all cell phones.
- Minimize opening refrigerator and freezer doors during the outage.
