

PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE OUTAGE



DATE: Friday, April 3, 2026
TIME: 8:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. (6 hours)
FEEDER: A portion of P-046
VILLAGE: Dededo (Route 3 Brigadier General Ben Blaz Memorial Highway area)

AREA: Customers affected are along a portion of Route 3 Brigadier General Ben Blaz Memorial Highway, from the entrances of Lobo Street up to Hahasu Drive, to include Calle Duenas, Chedo Lane, Inda Street, a portion of North Ukudo Street, Chalan Emo, Biradan Kantit, Chalan Kantit, and surrounding areas.

Other customers affected include Guam Waterworks Authority PRV Site, South Finegayan Housing, The Village Kidney Care Center, Fresenius Kidney Care, Chrysalis Child Care 2, Print by Design, Café O'Lake, Serrano Construction and Development Corp., Nama LLC, Lin's Hardware, AEP Inc., Okkodo High School, Aeromodelers Club of Flying, Core Tech International, Leidos Inc., Summer Vista Apartments, Guam Daily Post Printing Facility, Pacific Industrial Park, Astro America Gamma, Rocky Mountain Precast, Pacific Rim Contractors Inc., Fin Japanese Restaurant, iMart, Mail Room Plus, The Giving Tree Children's Academy, Tropical Blooms & Green Guam, and surrounding customers.

SCOPE OF WORK: GPA Line crew will be replacing wooden poles with concrete poles and installing vertical switches.

In addition, one (1) traffic light along Route 3 will be affected during this outage.

1) Traffic light at the intersection of Route 3 and Okkodo High School.

Please use caution when driving in this area. Motorists should expect traffic delays.

WHY WILL MY POWER BE OFF?

GPA makes system improvements and conducts preventative maintenance to avoid future power outages. In most cases, the job can be done with no impact to customers; however, sometimes the power needs to be shut off in order for the crews to work safely. Isolating power lines are necessary for safety precaution. We understand that this can be inconvenient and uncomfortable. We are committed to keeping our customers and employees safe and we will turn the power back on as soon as we can.

WHAT CAN I DO?

- **If you have a generator, make sure your main breaker is in the open position for the safety of our line crew.**
- Have a plan for alternate power source for electrical medical equipment.
- Charge all cell phones.
- Minimize opening refrigerator and freezer doors during the outage.
